## BEFORE INSTALLATION

### Your System Estimate

1



We'll send you a reminder 24 hours before your system estimate appointment is set to begin.

2

During your estimate appointment we will walk your property with you to better understand your needs as well as the nuances of your lawn.

After we look over your property, we will sit down with you to discuss budget, project timelines, and draw up a rough design for the system.

4

At the end of your appointment, we will provide you with an estimate and answer any questions you may have. After your appointment, we will email you a final contract with deposit and payment details.



## DURING INSTALLATION

### Your New Sprinkler System

All required permits, if applicable, will be pulled prior to starting your project.

2

Several municipal or utility locator companies will come by 2 – 3 days before your installation date to flag and mark public utilities.

The day before installation, a leader from our team will lay out the design of your system using colored flags that will be placed throughout the yard.

4

Installation day! After your system is in the ground, we will clean up your yard and run a system test.



5



A crew leader will walk you through how to operate your new system.

## AFTER INSTALLATION

### Fine Tuning

1

2-3 weeks after installation, we will follow up with you to perform an in-depth test and make any final adjustments after the components have had time to settle into the earth.

We will activate your annual maintenance plan to make sure your 5-year warranty is valid.
